Supervisor opened with pledge at 7pm.

Minutes from April 11, 2022 presented. Motion by Newell, 2nd by Frandsen to approve minutes. Motion passed.

Treasurer's report \$374,633.71 in general account. Income \$17,153.23, Expenses \$11,721.40.
Covid money \$102,553.24 plus 1.68 interest for balance of 102,554.94,
Motion by Frandsen, 2nd by Newell to accept treasurer's report, motion passed.

Planning Commission: report by Andi Knapp, Michelle Germain resigned, list of 5 people interested in serving given to board. Email board if anyone else is interested.

Wind Ordinance returned from County Planning Commission with a few suggested changes. Next projects are a solar ordinance and updating ordinances in the ordinance book.

Information presented about seminars to attend for MTA and a package to purchase from MTA for trainings for the board. Quote from BS & A on possible software for clerk.

New Business

Road work contracts discussed: finish Black Rd, three Chloride applications on dirt roads, Limestone part of Kendaville, Rotomill and pave part of Grant St, asphalt on part of First ST and some brush work and ditchwork. Motion to sign contracts by Frandsen, 2nd by Newell Motion passed.

Memorial day program to be at Coral cemetery May 30 at 11am, in case of inclement weather the service will be held at Emmanuel Baptist Church.

Motion by Newell, 2nd by Frandsen to pay \$50 for speaker for the service and \$50 for treats for the kids. Motion passed.

Clean up day, June 18th, 2022, 8am to Noon unless dumpsters are full before noon, 6 dumpsters ordered. Only for Maple Valley Township residents. More info will be available on the website and flyers will be posted around Coral and Trufant.

Roof Repair project: materials are two months out, they have repaired what they can to help protect it so far.

Reading of the bills Ck# 8978 to Ck# 9008 for \$13,020.01. Motion by Frandsen, 2nd by Newell to pay bills, motion passed.

Items of interest: Election had 232 voters, 135 were Absentee Voters.
